- Day trip travel, must live in WV (mileage is covered).
- Promote and gather turnout for community events hosted by WV4EF in assigned neighborhoods throughout West Virginia.
- Collect signatures on petitions in alignment with campaign priorities.
- Engage residents in open and honest conversations about their experiences with rising electricity costs.
